1 2	Resolution Specifying the Minimum Number of Hours to Graduate after the Transition from Quarters to Semesters

6	Whereas in October 2008 the Ohio University Board of Trustees, in response to the suggestion
7	from the Ohio Chancellor, approved the transition of the University from quarters to semesters
8	for 2012-2013 academic year; and
9	101 2012 2010 4044041110) 042, 4114
10	Whereas the current general education requirements are expressed in terms of quarter hours and
11	will no longer be applicable after the transition to semesters in Fall 2012; and
12	
13	Whereas, as pointed out by the Academic Calendar and System Committee, under a semester
14	system with a majority of the courses being 3 semester hours a student would need to average
15	more than five courses per semester in order to graduate in four years if the current minimum
16	number of hours to graduate with a bachelor's degree (192 quarter hours) is simply multiplied by
17	2/3 to determine new requirement (128 semester hours); and
18	
19	Whereas 120 semester hours in a four year bachelor's program could be satisfied by taking five
20	3-hour courses each semester; therefore
21	
22	Be it resolved that the minimum number of semester hours to graduate with a bachelor's degree
23 24	be 120 semester hours to be effective Fall 2012.
24	
25	Be it further resolved that the minimum number of semester hours to graduate with a associate's
26	degree be 60 semester hours to be efective Fall 2012.
27	
28	Be it further resolved that the registrar develop and insert language into the appropriate catalogs
29	that implements this resolution.
