

**Sense of the Senate Resolution on Changing the Management Structure  
of the Chief Financial Officer Position

**Whereas**, the Chief Information Officer of Ohio University is a dual reporting position, reporting to both the President and Provost, and thus provides precedent for dual reporting positions in upper administration;

**Whereas**, the Chief Financial Officer makes decisions affecting the core teaching and research missions of the university,

**Be it resolved** that the Chief Financial Officer report to the Provost in addition to the President.
