

**Resolution to Update Methods of Notification for Faculty Senate
Meetings

Whereas the current bylaws of the Faculty Senate do not reflect the methods of communication most often used within Ohio University, and

Whereas other electronic means of communication may supersede email in the future,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Bylaws at Handbook Section VI.B.4.a, which currently reads

Notice of meetings may be given by campus or U.S. mail or by telephone. Mailed notices of meetings must be given so as to be received at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting. If the member cannot be reached personally, leaving a telephone message announcing the meeting with a responsible person at the member's house or office, at least four hours prior to the meeting, will constitute sufficient notice,

be replaced with the following:

Notice of meetings may be given by electronic communication, campus or U.S. mail, or by telephone, ordinarily so as to be received at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting. In extraordinary circumstances, notice still must be given at least four hours prior to the meeting.
