

Dr. Shiyong Wu, Professor of <u>Chemistry & Biochemistry</u> at Ohio University, received a John C. Baker Fund award of \$12,000 for his work on "The Role of Carnosol in Preventing Skin Cancer Development."

The <u>John C. Baker Fund awarded \$67,163 total</u> to six faculty proposals for research, scholarship and creative work during spring semester 2017.

Endowed in 1961 by a gift of more than \$612,000 from 1926 College of Arts & Sciences graduate Edwin L. Kennedy and his wife, Ruth, a 1930 graduate of the College of Education, the John C. Baker Fund was established to support faculty improvement and research efforts. Up to \$12,000 is available for each award.

The Baker Fund committee received 13 proposals requesting \$153,334 total.
